

POTENTIAL RISKS:

ACCIDENTS TO CHILDREN AND ADULTS IN THE SCHOOL CAR-PARK, ENTRANCE PATHS AND ON THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS NEAR TO THE SCHOOL

SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR DRIVERS AND PEDESTRIANS TO REDUCE THE RISKS OF ACCIDENTS WHEN VISITING BRENT KNOLL PRIMARY SCHOOL:

For All:

- ✓ All drivers visiting the school must respect our neighbours and not park inconsiderately in the locality of our school, such as by blocking drives or parking on pavements
- ✓ The school will regularly remind parents of the need for safe parking around school via the newsletter and by displaying a banner on the external fencing.
- ✓ The school will work the Police and Local Authority during the year in order to provide a safe environment for families, school staff, visitors and the local community.
- ✓ Dogs are not allowed to be walked into the car-park or other school grounds.
- ✓ Pedestrians entering our site must use the allocated pedestrian paths as marked. Pedestrians are to keep to the pathway and not walk across the car park area or allow children to climb the adjoining wall.
- ✓ Children are permitted to ride bicycles and scooters to school and use the bike shed for storage during the school day. Pupils must dismount from their bicycles and scooters when entering the school site and keep to the pathways. They are not to cross the car-park or ride on the paths or playground within the school site.
- ✓ There is to be no parking on the yellow zig-zag lines outside the school, or in the bay at the entrance to the car-park marked bus-stop.
- ✓ Local speed-watch team will be encouraged to work with the school to maintain safer driving in the locality of the school.

For Staff:

- ✓ The school car-park is a staff car-park and staff must exercise due care and attention when driving and manoeuvring in the car park.
- ✓ Users of the school-car park do so at their own risk. Brent Knoll Primary School will not accept responsibility for damage, accident or loss to vehicles or contents.
- ✓ Access for emergency vehicles must be maintained at all time. Please do not park in the centre of the car-park blocking the double gates to the playground.
- ✓ All children need to be escorted by an adult when in the school car-park.
