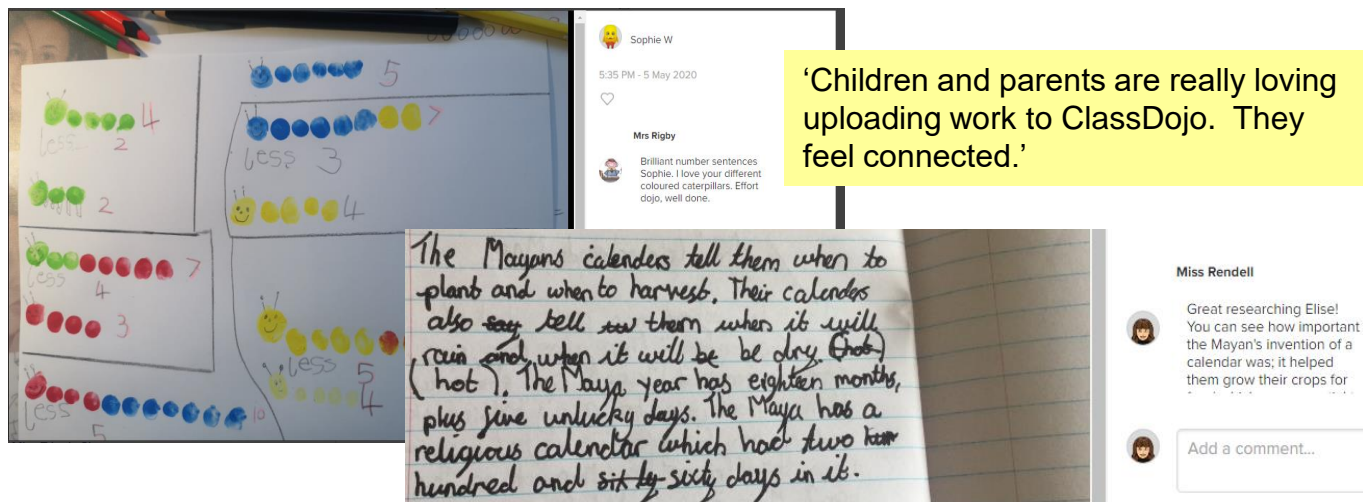


St Louis have used the school website <https://www.stlouisfrome.co.uk> as a hub for their home learning and extended their previous use of ClassDojo. Through ClassDojo families are able to share the activities they are doing with their class teacher. Children upload their work so that teachers can look at it, comment and award 'Dojo' points.



At the beginning of each week families go to the [Home Learning Page](#) where **English and Maths Home learning packs** are available for each year group with daily activities and resources. Alongside this, each teacher has planned a six week home learning topic with a range of activities from across the curriculum around a common theme. There is also a weekly task to support learning in RE. In addition resources are available on the [SEND](#) page that have been collated by SEND Professional Advisory Services for Inclusion.

Work shared is celebrated on a weekly gallery page created on the website. This mirrors the celebration assemblies that are part of school life and allows children to share their work with everyone. Children are also up loading all sorts of other stuff that they just want their teachers to see. Teachers are happy to comment on everything, including how beautiful their cat is and how yummy their biscuits look!

The next adventure for the school is to set up a virtual sports day on their Facebook page. All the Dojo for that week will relate to health and fitness.

Expectations: Teachers upload and respond to a daily task within working hours.

Use: Interactions between families and school have now reached almost 100%.
