- Live in Ilminster or have done so within the 12 months immediately prior to the closing date for nominations

OR

- Go to school in Ilminster

OR

- Be an active member of an Ilminster based organisation.
- The award may be issued posthumously provided that the nomination closing date is no more than 1 year since the nominee deceased.
