

Classroom Online Safety Rules

- 1) If a message comes up on the screen, always tell a teacher.
- 2) Turn over the device or minimise the picture if you see something inappropriate and then tell a teacher.
- 3) Be careful that you don't spend too long on a device, especially during golden time or wet playtime.
- 4) Ask an adult if you are allowed on a device.
- 5) Make sure you have an adult supervising you whilst you are on a device at school.
- 6) Use safe search engines such as www.primaryschoolict.com or www.swiggle.co.uk
- 7) Make sure you check reliability of information by seeing if one or two other websites give the same information.
- 8) Always give good advice to your classmates whilst online.
- 9) Make sure you use your own username when logging in to the computers or keep a note of which computer/device you have used.
