Goes live from 9am There are two elements to the Bitesize Daily, both designed to be flexible in their use. Take a look at each and give it a try!

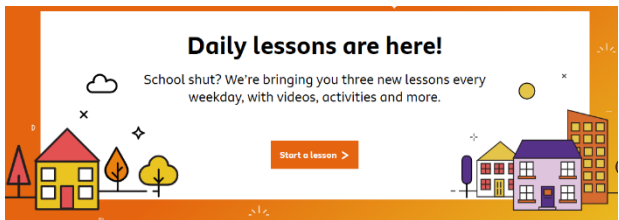
