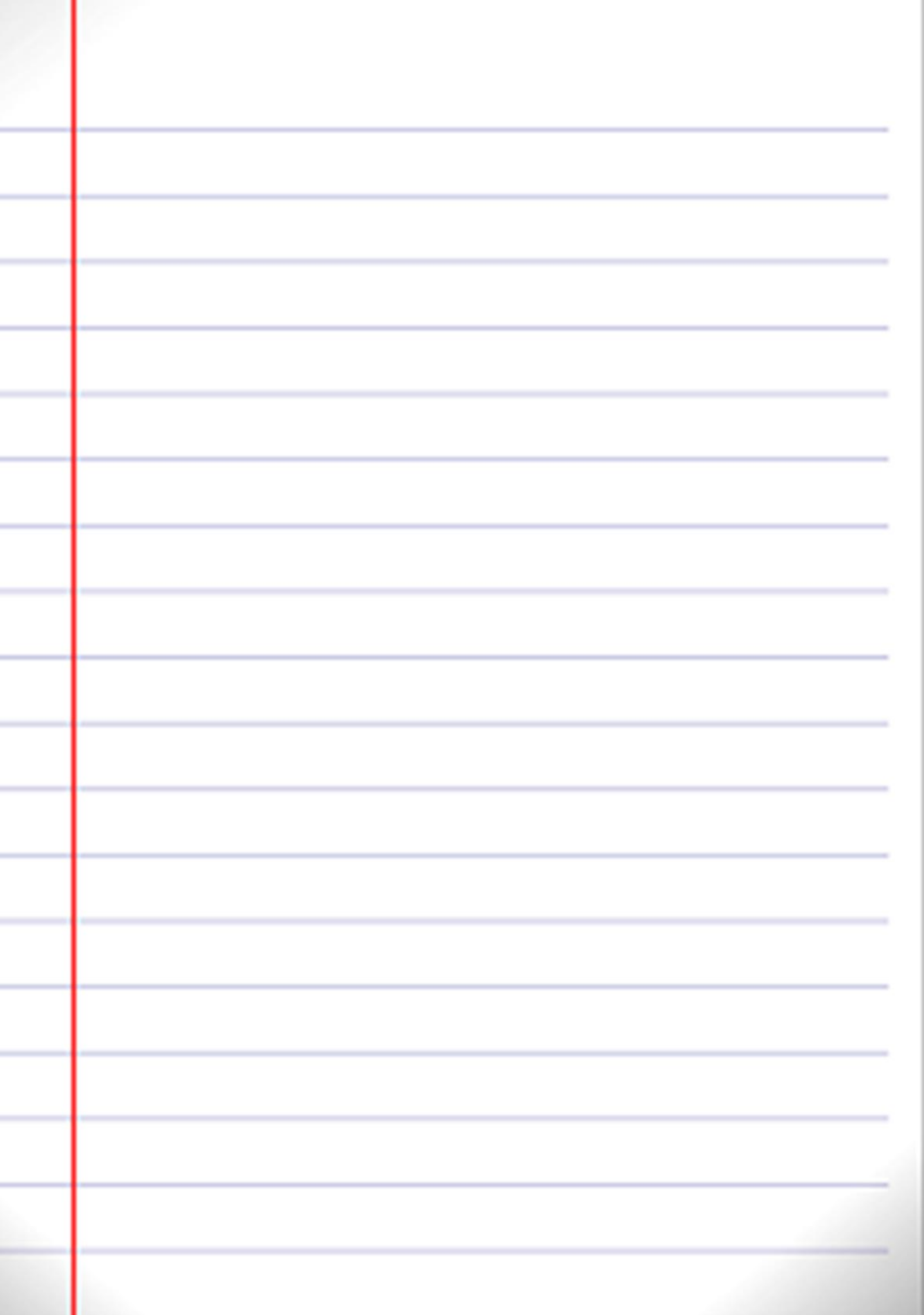
Task 3

How to grow a sunflower

You will need:

- A sunny spot
- Sunflower seeds
- A small pot
- A large pot
- A bag of compost
- Some small stones
- A watering can
- Some gloves
- Cane
- String

Instructions

1. Find a space outside or cover the floor with newspaper to avoid a mess.
2. Put some small stones in the bottom of the pot.
3. Fill the pot with compost. If the bag of compost is heavy, ask a grown up to help.
4. Open the packet of seeds.
5. Using the gloves, press two seeds into the soil. Leave a gap between them.

6. Water your *seeds*, then place the pot outside in a light spot. If you can't put your pot outside, find a sunny windowsill.

A sunflower
